### Goalkeepers (In Addition To The Designated Full – Camper / Commuter List)

- Long Sleeve Training Tops (Optional)
- Training Pants (Less Experienced Keepers Should Consider This)
- Goalkeeper Gloves

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You may also consider other items that you may want to have with you for the week: stationary, stamps, camera, small portable radio etc. **Do not bring large, bulky, or high valued items such as lap tops or stereo systems.**

Centre College will do everything possible to insure that each camper is treated with respect along with their respective belongings. You should not bring items of high value though, it only attracts unwanted behavior. Centre College can not be held liable for stolen belongings.

Laundry Facilities (coin-operated washing machines, dryers, and soap vending machines) are located in the residence halls.

While Centre College Resident Halls are air conditioned, often times a fan is good to have in extreme conditions. All Dorm Rooms have phone jacks, so if you plan to bring a phone from home for use during the week, feel free to do so. A calling card will be necessary to make long distance calls.

Participants are expected to respect the rights of others and to follow the directions of staff members. Therefore I agree to:

1. Participate to the best of my ability in all facets of the program and attend scheduled activities promptly.

Please be advised that under Kentucky statute, Senate Bill 63, each college or university in the state must disclose to all lessees of on-campus housing facilities whether the facility where you will be housed is equipped with an “automatic fire suppression system,” or in other words, a sprinkler system.

The only residential facility on campus that has an automatic fire suppression system is Breckenridge Hall. The other halls and houses are NOT equipped with such systems, which are not required in buildings three stories or less.

All facilities are equipped with fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, and alarm systems. The residences on College Street, Grant Street, Fifth Street, and St. Mildred’s Court do not have alarm systems.
