## CHECKLIST & REMINDERS

### Registration and Checkout:

- Campers will be staying in the Discovery Hall dorm which is located on the southeast side of campus. The physical address is 906 Virginia Ave, Columbia, MO 65201. Please use the Virginia Avenue entrance. Parking will be available in the metered lot on the west side of Virginia Avenue as well as the 4<sup>th</sup> level of the Virginia Avenue parking garage.
- Registration will begin on Monday from 12-1pm in the lobby entrance of Discovery Hall.
- The Camp check-out and awards ceremony will begin on Friday at 2pm in the Lobby/Atrium of Discovery Hall. Parents are more than welcome to attend the awards ceremony.

### Things to Bring:

- Golf clothes for the appropriate number of days. Please include collared shirts and Bermuda length shorts. Old Hawthorne is a private club with a strict dress code. Campers must wear golf appropriate attire. All clothing and personal items should have your name or identification on them.
- Golf Bag. A lightweight carry bag is recommended.
- Old Hawthorne does not rent pull carts. If you choose to use a pull cart during camp, you must bring your own.
- Sneakers. Many times camper's feet will get sore from wearing golf shoes all day. It's nice to have something different to put on.
- Soap, shampoo, bath towel, pillow, and toiletries.
- An extra golf glove, athletic-tape, and Band-Aids.
- Any medications you need.
- **Sunscreen (A must!)**
- Umbrella and rain gear (if you have it)
- Golf Equipment: Clubs, Shoes, Gloves, Golf Balls, Tees
- If the schedule permits, we will have a pizza and pool party one evening so throw in a bathing suit and an extra towel if you would like to swim.

### Cell Phones:

- Cell phones will only be allowed at designated times and in case of emergency.

### Spending Money:

- Students should only bring a nominal amount of money. Pro Shop items and snacks will be available both at Old Hawthorne and Discovery Hall.

### Rules & Regulations:

- If a camper drives their own car to camp, they must purchase a parking pass (\$12 per week). All vehicles will remain parked for the entire camp session. Only during an emergency and with parent's permission, will anyone be allowed to operate a vehicle during camp. The University takes no responsibility for lost or stolen items or damage to vehicles.
- No Alcoholic beverages, tobacco, drugs, fireworks, firearms, or weapons are allowed. Parents of violators will be notified and students will be sent home. No refunds will be given to campers who violate these rules.
- Campers are expected to behave like ladies and gentlemen. They are also expected to respect the property and rights of others. Students with discipline problems will be sent home without refund. In addition, parents are responsible for any financial damages caused by their child.
- All golf course "Guests Rules" apply to campers.

- Take exit 124 onto Stadium Blvd and head southeast towards campus
- Turn left onto College Avenue
- Turn left onto Hospital Drive
- Turn right onto Virginia Avenue
- Park in the metered lot or the 4<sup>th</sup> level of the Virginia Avenue parking structure
- Please refer to the map for dorm location

### **Directions from i70 westbound:**

- Take exit 128A onto Hwy 63 south
- Exit onto Stadium Blvd and head west towards campus
- Turn right onto College Avenue
- Turn left onto Hospital Drive
- Turn right onto Virginia Avenue
- Park in the metered lot or the 4<sup>th</sup> level of the Virginia Avenue parking structure
